FISHING REPORT – WEEK ENDING 29/1/12

Last week 78 rods caught 238 fish for an average of 3.05.

All of the pools have been in fine form this week with lots of fish in the 3 – 6lb bracket coming out along with a few larger specimens.

The biggest fish of the week was an 11lb rainbow caught by \*Roy Deeley of Knowle who was fishing from the bank of Cocks Close and this fell to a Cats Whisker fished on an intermediate line and Roy had seven other fish too. Kieran Biggins of Rugby used a small fry imitation to tempt a 6lb 12oz rainbow from a boat on Cocks Close

On the Park Meadow Pool, Graham Edwards of Coventry caught five fish to 4lb on black Buzzers. On the Great Pool, Alan Beckett of Wythall caught seven fish which all came to a white Minkie Lure fished on a sinking line.

The top patterns have been Cats Whisker, white Fritz, Minkie, black Tadpole, Viva, Damsel Nymph, Bloodworm and black Buzzer.

Best areas have been the road bank and the high bank on Cocks Close, the shallow water on Great Pool and the dam wall area on Park Meadow.
